Agentic Al is being used in some capacity at businesses of all sizes, grounding the hype in reality. While small businesses report relatively low usage, their familiarity with the technology is noteworthy, with 21% saying they're familiar and 48% saying they're somewhat familiar.1

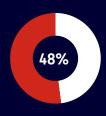

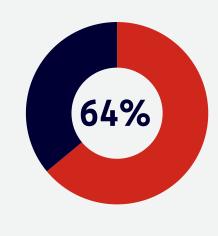
